THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAGINAW, NEWTON COUNTY, MISSOURI, CONCERNING: THE PAYMENT OF ATTORNEY FEES INCURRED IN THE EXPENSE OF INCORPORATING THE TOWN OF SAGINAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SAGINAW, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

SECTION 1. Whereas Paul E. Carver an attorney of Neosho, Missouri, has heretofore performed all of the necessary legal services in the incorporating of said Town of Saginaw.

(1) That said services rendered were valuable and of benefit to said town and that said services were of the reasonable value as follows:

(a) For legal services rendered in the incorporation proceedings before the Newton County Court on April 6, 1957......\$ 250.00.

(b) For preparation of ordinances......\$ 125.00.

(2) That said indebtedness is a valid and reasonable charge for services and said counsel does hereby obligate the said Town of Saginaw to pay same and does hereby pledge the full faith and credit of the Town of Saginaw to pay same.

SECTION 2. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force after its passage and approval.
