

THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAGINAW, NEWTON COUNTY, MISSOURI CONCERNING THE COMMERCIAL FEEDING OF LIVE STOCK WITHIN THE COPERATE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED NY ~~THE~~ BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SAGINAW AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That the commercial feeding of livestock within the limits of the Town of Saginaw, Newton County, Missouri is hereby prohibited.


SECTION 2. That the term "commercial feeding" is to mean any group of five or more animals confined to close quarters and being fed.

SECTION 3. No exception to this Ordinance may be made except upon written request by the owner of the animals in question and receipt of written approval by the Board of Trustees stating therein what conditions are required and stating a definate length of time to be effective.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its' passage and approval.
