## ORDINANCE NO. 79-2

THE SA.1-vrn BEING AN ORDIHANCE CF THE VILLAGE OF SAGINA'J, MISSOURI, DEFINING NULSANCES 'WITHIN TF, E VILLAGE AND PROVIDING *FOR* ABATEMENT OF THE SAI1E.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD *OE* TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW, MIS.SOITRI, AS FOLLm.JS:

<u>SECTION 1</u> - <u>Definition of Nuisance</u>. For the purpose of this ordinance the term nuisance is defined to mean any condition or use of premises or of building exteriors which is detrimental to the property of others or which causes or tends to cause substantial diminutiQn in the value of other property in the neighborhood in ,,, hich said premises are loc7-ted. This includes but is not limited to the keeping, depositing, scattering over the premises or allowing to remain--nn---the :premises any of the following:

1. Abandoned, discarded or unused objects or equipment, such as automobiles, furniture, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, cans or containeEs.

2. Carcases of dead animals remaining exposed more than 6 hours after death.

3. Ashes, cinders, slops, filth, excretement, sawdust, tree limbs, piled brush, used lumber and other building materials, stones, rocks, dirt, straw, soot, sticks, shavings, cans, paper, trash, rubbish, manure, refuse, offal, waste water, fish, putrid meat, entrals, decayed fruit or vegetables, brokeri wire, regs, old china, old iron or other metal, wrecked or salvaged automobiles, old wearing apparel, all animal or vegetable matter, all dead animals or any other offensive or disagreeable substance or thing which is thrown, left or deposited or caused to be left, thrown or deposited by any person in or upon any street, avenue, alley, sidewalk, :parking or other public way or any public enclosure, or any lot vacant or occupied if in the Village or any pool or pond of water.

4. Hog pens.

5. Privies which overflow, leak or are in a filthy condition.

6. Pools or ponds of stagnant or unclean water.
