ORDINANCE NO. 87-1

An Ordinance designating a one-way street within the Village of Saginaw, Missouri.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Saginaw, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established a one-way street upon Bartlett Avenue for a distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet South (S) of the intersection of Bartlett Avenue and old Highway 71 (also known as Saginaw Road) all as located in the Village of Saginaw, Missouri.

Section 2. The chairman of the Board of Trustees or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and directed to insure that proper markings are installed and maintained upon said one-way street to indicate the nature and extent thereof.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person operating a motor vehicle upon said street to travel in a northerly direction thereon within the zone specified.

Section 4. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be fined not more than Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) in amount.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
