

ORDINANCE NO. 95-2

BILL NO. 95-2

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EVERY PERSON ENGAGED IN ANY OCCUPATION, TRADE, PURSUIT, BUSINESS OR VOCATION WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW TO OBTAIN A BUSINESS LICENSE; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSES; AND CONTAINING AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Saginaw wishes to license and regulate all occupations, trades, pursuits, businesses and vocations within the Village of Saginaw in accordance with Section 80.090 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SAGINAW, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Every person engaged in any occupation, trade, pursuit, business or vocation, or engaged in the keeping or maintaining of any institution, establishment, article or commodity shall procure a license for the privilege in engaging in same within the limits of the Village.

SECTION 2. Every application for a Village license shall be made upon a form prescribed, prepared and furnished by the License Officer and shall set forth the applicant's sales tax identification number and such other information as said License Officer shall require. There shall be no fee for such license.

SECTION 3. Upon approval of the application for a business license, the License Officer shall grant and issue to the applicant a license as provided in this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Business licenses shall not be assignable and shall be valid only for the persons in whose names issued and for the transaction of business in the places designated therein.

SECTION 5. Every license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance shall at all times be conspicuously displayed at the place for which issued.

SECTION 6. All licenses issued under the provisions of this Ordinance shall expire on the 31st day of January in each and every year unless sooner suspended, surrendered or revoked for cause by the License Officer.

SECTION 7. Whenever any business license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance is defaced, destroyed or lost, the License Officer shall issue a duplicate license for the defaced, destroyed or lost license upon the payment of the cost of issuing such duplicate.

SECTION 8. Any license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance may be revoked by the License Officer for the violation by the licensee of any provision of this Ordinance or any

rules or regulations of the License Officer prescribed or promulgated under this Ordinance, or for the violation by the licensee of state law, rule or regulation. In the event of any such revocation, the licensee shall have the right of appeal of such action to the Board of Trustees upon notice of such appeal duly filed by the licensee with the Village Clerk within ten days of such action.

SECTION 9. No license required under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be issued by the License Officer to any person until such person produces a copy of a certificate of insurance for workers' compensation coverage if the applicant for license is required to cover his liability under Chapter 287 RSMo. It shall be unlawful for any applicant to provide fraudulent information to the License Officer.

SECTION 10. Any person who knowingly makes a false statement in the application for a license under this Ordinance, or who shall otherwise violate the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 11. The License Officer shall prescribe the form of all licenses and shall sign all licenses. Each license shall contain the licensee's sales tax identification number so that same is visibly displayed.

SECTION 12. Whenever any applicant for license under this Ordinance is engaged in more than one occupation, trade, pursuit, business or vocation at the same address and location, such applicant shall make application for a separate license for each occupation, trade, pursuit, business or vocation carried on at such address and location.

SECTION 13. A License Officer shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Saginaw, Missouri and shall serve a term of one year.

SECTION 14. Any village occupation license applied for or issued pursuant to this Ordinance before or after a revocation of the Missouri Retail Sales License by the Missouri Director of Revenue, shall, during the continuation of the revocation of the State Retail Sales License, be null and void.

SECTION 15. This Ordinance being for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in that it provides for the licensing of all businesses and vocations conducted within the Village of Saginaw, is considered an emergency measure and as such this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Board of Trustees.
