

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE
MAXIMUM SPEED WHICH A VEHICLE
MAY BE OPERATED WITHIN THE
VILLAGE OF SAGINAW, AND
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
EXCEEDING THE SPEED LIMIT.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
SAGINAW, NEWTON COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle upon
any street within the Village of Saginaw in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

SECTION 2: Violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall
be punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 3: This Ordinance having been available for public inspection prior to its
consideration by the Board of Trustees, and having been read by title twice prior to
passage, shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Board of Trustees.
