





AN ORDINANCE SELECTING ORDINANCE NO. 97-2, PASSED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW ON THE 11TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1997, WHICH ORDINANCE SETS THE MAXIMUM SPEED WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE OPERATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW AND PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR EXCEEDING THE SPEED LIMIT, AS AN ORDINANCE TO BE CERTIFIED TO THE NEWTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FOR ENFORCEMENT PURSUANT TO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW AND THE NEWTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAGINAW, NEWTON COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Saginaw hereby select Ordinance Number 97-2 passed by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Saginaw on the 11th day of November, 1997, which ordinance sets the maximum speed which a vehicle may be operated within the Village of Saginaw and provides penalties for exceeding the speed limit, as an ordinance to be certified to the Newton County Sheriff's Department for enforcement pursuant to an agreement between the Village of Saginaw and the Newton County Sheriff's Department.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance having been available for public inspection prior to its consideration by the Board of Trustees, and having been read by title twice prior to passage, shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Board of Trustees.
